

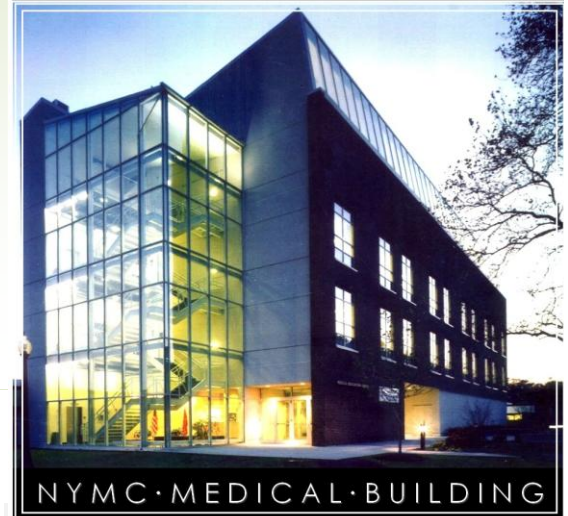
# Medical Degree in China

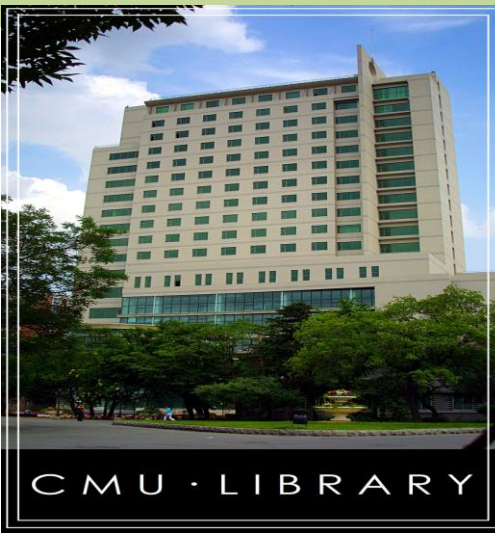

pharmaceuticals and this often times causes the misuse of drugs. The Degree in China program affords you the advantage of obtaining a MBBS degree and Master equivalent Certificate of Completion in Clinical Pharmacy, which other medical schools do not offer. Not only will be you trained as a physician, but you will also have profound knowledge of drug safety and management. Not only will you have these qualifications, but you will have more opportunities to do more hands on training and see more patients as you complete your hospital rotations at CMU, which has 6,469 beds. This is 50% more than all of the southern California medical school hospitals combined.

### The USMLE

The USMLE is designed to assess

“a physician's ability to apply knowledge, concepts, & principles, & to demonstrate fundamental patient-centered skills, that are important in health and disease and that constitute the basis of safe and effective patient care” –www.usmle.org

Beth Healthcare will walk you through the process and help you to pass the USMLE. You will be able to take the USMLE step 1 in English in China after completing 2 years of Medical Science courses. The step 2 CK will be taken after your 4<sup>th</sup> year. Step 2 CS is taken during your 5<sup>th</sup> year in the U.S.

Our students will go through one year of clinical training at NYMC, where you will be provided with clinical experience and extended electives. During this time electives may be taken at NYMC or other teaching hospitals across the country, giving you the opportunity to practice at the hospital that you wish to apply for your residency.

Residency matching is not guaranteed whether you complete your medical degree in the United States or whether you complete your medical degree in China. What Beth Healthcare does, is to present you in your best light by giving you a strong resume in comparison to other candidates. The qualifications you will earn during the Medical Degree in China program will give you the best potential in getting your residency match. You will be provided with two dean's letters of recommendation, be equipped with a dual major in Medical Science and Clinical Pharmacy, and will have the ability to be familiarized with the hospital where you would like to apply for residency match. Beth Healthcare will help you stand out and put your best foot forward as a medical student.
